Hayrides & Tower Tours



Hayrides will depart from Apple Tree Alley and travel up to Chenocetah Tower

\$3 per adult person
(anyone over the age of 12)

Children 12 and under are FREE with paying adult passenger (limit 4 kids per adult)

US Forestry Service will operate FREE tours up to top of the tower all day during the festival.
