6 Security for the acquisition, construction, renovation, or  
7 expansion of any U.S. Immigration and Enforcement de-  
8 tention center located in Social Circle, Georgia or Oak-

1 wood, Georgia unless such action in either such location  
2 is explicitly authorized by an Act of Congress.

3 (b) Any acquisition, construction, or expansion by  
4 U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement of a facility  
5 intended to be used for the detention of noncitizens in So-  
6 cial Circle, Georgia or Oakwood, Georgia shall be subject  
7 to all applicable environmental laws and inspection re-  
8 quirements, including the completion of an environmental  
9 impact statement required under the National Environ-  
10 mental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.) and  
11 site assessments required under the Comprehensive Envi-  
12 ronmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of  
13 1980 (42 U.S.C. 9601 et seq.).
